

## The Marion - Harry Ball - Leary Residence 141 Fern Ave.

**Jack Hughes** built this Sears home in the early 1930's for the **Harry Ball** family. It has been identified as the Marion #13333 and is currently owned by **Penny and John Leary**. The cost of the kit was \$1,495. The catalogue called attention to the bungalow's graceful, sloping roof line and large, gabled dormer in the second story.



In 1942, Keith & Gretchen Hollister purchased the Ball home and opened their original Holly Woodworking gift shop on the enclosed front porch. Although Sears did ship garage kits, it is not certain if the one pictured here is a Sears, or one that was added later. Photo courtesy of Annette Vogel.
